While there is a federal moratorium on some evictions, there is no moratorium on utility disconnections. Utility shut offs do lead to tenants being displaced. Eviction, especially during winter, will increase street homelessness and is another way that people could be vulnerable to increased infection rates. Please put a moratorium in place immediately and extend it until CO-VID 19 is under control and people are able to work in a fully functioning economy. Your action will save lives.
