Users can explore the data through a guided **step-by-step process**, selecting an indicator and geographies they are most interested in.

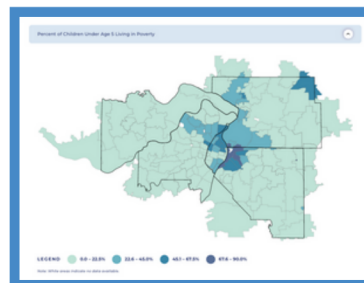


COMPREHENSIVE DATA

Includes 6 fundamental need areas and more than **40 indicators** related to child well-being from cradle to career.

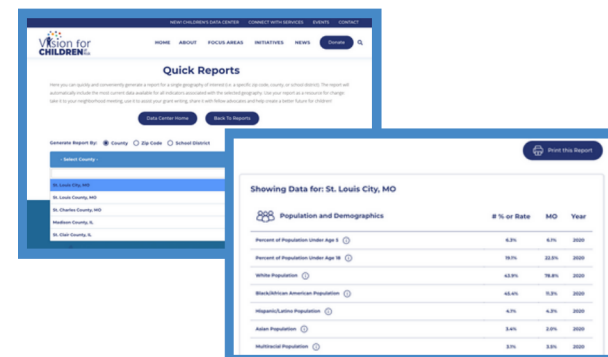
INTERACTIVE
