HOW TO GET INVOLVED

FAMILY ENGAGEMENT SUPPORT SERVICES

Family Engagement Specialists are mentors with lived experience ready to walk alongside you and help you make lasting connections to support your family. They understand the complexities of life and trust you as the expert on your family. We will be there with you as you navigate the child welfare system.

PARENT ADVISORY COUNCIL

Families should be at the center of decisions that impact them. The Parent Advisory Councils (PACs) help us make that happen. PACs put leadership and decision-making power back in your hands and connect you to a broad network of systems change makers.

PARENT CAFES

Cafés are hosted by parents for parents. Parent Cafés provide parents and caregivers a safe and welcoming space to connect and learn from each other. They are centered on the Strengthening Families™ Five Protective Factors:

Vitality Cafés grew out of the Parent Café experience that parents have come to love. Vitality Cafés, or the Journey to Vitality, is focused on ensuring individuals are well. A thriving parent can be their best self for their children and the community!

Community Cafés are all about conversations that matter. We take community issues; we create a safe space for community members and stakeholders to talk; we learn and grow together; and we take action together.
