



# LOGIC MODEL

## TARGET POPULATION



- Families enrolled in TANF, based in the St. Louis and New Madrid County areas



## INPUTS



- Research Advocate staff at Vision for Children at Risk (St. Louis) and the New Madrid County Family Resource Center
- Unite Us service referral platform, tracks the family's service journey and outcomes
- Lived experience of families is gathered in assessments, program evaluations, and community forums such as Parent Cafes



## ACTIVITIES



- Program referrals from DSS Family Services Division to the LIFT MO Resource Advocates
- Conduct family assessments to identify needs and resource gaps
- Engage families through coaching and mentorship
- Referral to local resources through provider partner networks
- Follow up with families and provider partners and providing supports as needed
- Maintain a current resource directory

## OUTPUTS



- Numbers of families recruited and referred
- Numbers of referrals and service types
- Numbers of assessments and evaluations conducted
- Percentages of families achieving increased protective factors
- Families' length of time engaged by the LIFT MO Resource Advocates



## SHORT-TERM OUTCOMES



- Families increase their knowledge of services
- Families have a resource to support stability
- Warm referrals increase communication between families and partners



## MEDIUM-TERM OUTCOMES



- Families increase their access to services
- Families increase social connections to support family stability
- Families increase protective factors and problem-solving skills



## LONG-TERM OUTCOMES



- Families experience increased social and economic mobility
- Stigma reduced against accessing community services
- Partners operate with deeper collaboration



## IMPACT



- Reduced child welfare involvement for families
- Increased self-sufficiency for families
- Policy and program shifts to address service gaps
- Multi-generational resilience, opportunity and thriving
